Strengths and Past Successes: Member has a good personality and is easy to talk to. Member does not exhibit significant behaviors when she has mental health supports. She works hard to monitor her health needs. Likes to work on crafts, sit outside and take walks around the house to get exercise.

Current Relevant Diagnoses: Congestive heart failure, hypertension, peripheral vascular disease, GERD, chronic kidney disorder, COPD, fatty liver, osteoarthritis, back pain, spinal stenosis, diabetes w/polyneuropathy, anxiety, PTSD, bipolar disorder, depression, and schizophrenia

Involved Team Members and Natural Supports: Capstone IHH, two close friends and a neighbor who act as natural supports

Current Placement/Services: Member resides in a home with 2 other females, one of which is her CDAC provider. She is also receiving home delivered meals.

Past Placements/Services: Nursing Facility, PERS

Precipitating Events/Triggers: Member and roommates are being evicted from the current home, and there are concerns of maltreatment, abuse, and exploitation by one roommate. Member would be better served in a Hab home setting.

Urgent Need and Recommended Setting: Member is facing homelessness and needs additional supports for supervision and to monitor and support her mental health. Member would like to reside in a Hab home to ensure proper cares and supports. She could reside in a setting that uses night owl.

Identified Barriers: Member has minimal behaviors but is dependent on a wheelchair and walker and needs a home that is handicap accessible. She has a lot of health needs and requires assistance to manage these.

Medication/Medical Challenges: Member needs assistance and reminders to take medication. Right side weakness and fine motor impairments. Uses a wheelchair for ambulation but can walk short distances with a walker.

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Supports and Services Available for Addressing Barriers/Challenges: Member is working with IHH peer support.

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
