Thanks for tuning in for one of IACP's most productive years yet. With each passing day, we continue to advance our mission and vision:

“Relentlessly advocating for Iowa’s community providers to build healthy communities, so one day, all Iowans will live, learn, and work, in their community of choice.”

Some of the ways we do this is by supporting our 130 member organizations through relentless advocacy at all levels; passing along to-the-minute updates from leaders we have established rapport with at the state, federal and local levels; networking and brainstorming; propelling individual employees forward with high-caliber training opportunities; gaining operational momentum in bettering business practices through IACP Strategic Business Partners and Business Solutions; and so much more.

As a direct result of the strong relationships we have built with IME, Iowa’s Health & Human Services department, Governor Kim Reynolds (who identified our industry as one of her top priorities), and others at the statehouse, we received a 4.25% rate increase for HCBS and Habilitation in 2022. We plan to continue our relentless advocacy on our “Close the Gap” campaign until DSPs have fair and comparable wages.

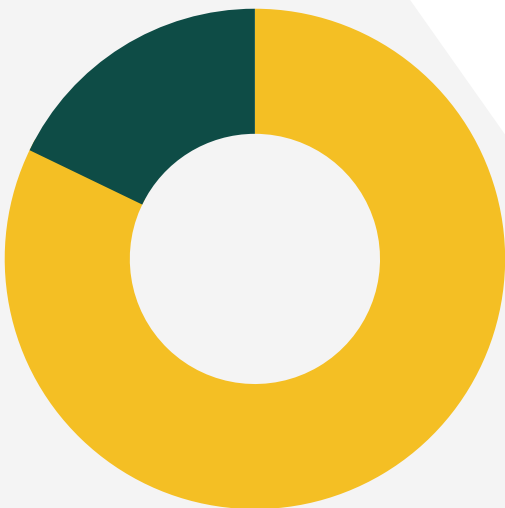
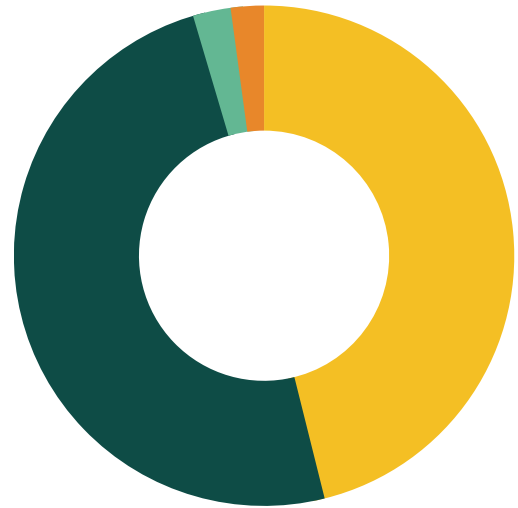
